Accreditation - Ensuring the Highest Standard of Care

Our Vision Centre Day Surgery has recently undergone its annual accreditation survey. Conducted by Global Mark, policy processes and procedures were reviewed under the ISO9001 (an international survey standard). VCDS scored 100% for the fifth year running. We are proud of the accomplishments of our Day Surgery; which is utilized by our Eye Surgeons to perform a full range of eye and eyelid operations; with cataract, retinal, oculoplastic, strabismus, and glaucoma surgery the commonest procedures performed.

The clinical outcomes and customer service are exemplary. Our Surgeons undertake regular reviews of surgical outcomes, as part of the accreditation process, and these are benchmarked against other like facilities. Process related to customer service are continually refined and upgraded. The Day Surgery conducts regular patient feedback surveys to ensure ongoing improvement in the services we offer. An advantage of having the Day Surgery in the same building as our Southport office is a seamless flow of the service we provide from a patient's clinic appointment to the completion of their surgery at the Vision Centre Day Surgery.

We have upgraded our theatre equipment with the Oculus Biom 4. This is a wid-angle viewing system attached to the operating microscope and used for vitreo-retinal surgery. It allows the Surgeon greater freedom of movement and improved surgical performance.

Advances Intraocular Lens Technology

Vision Centre Eye Surgeons are on the leading edge of intraocular lens techniques and treat both cataract and refractive errors this way. A range of lenses including multifocal lens to give near and distance vision without glasses, Toric lenses to correct astigmatism and secondary lens implants which can fitted inside the eye in front of an existing lens implant are available.






